AGREEMENT

The purpose of this agreement is to support signatory agencies (Armagh, Catholic Family Services, Catholic Cross-Cultural Services, Family Services of Peel, India Rainbow Community Services of Peel, Interim Place, Malton Neighborhood Services, Muslim Community Services, Oasis centre des femmes, Peel CAS, The Salvation Army Honeychurch Family Life Resource Centre, United Achievers' Community Services, Victim Services of Peel and Women's Counselling Centre) in keeping women and children safe while supporting them in accessing appropriate services, advocacy and transparent service delivery and coordination.

This agreement is used when both Peel CAS and VAW are involved in providing support to children and families. The agreement is to be reviewed and revised when family circumstances change or if there needs to be modifications to the safety plan.

The Peel CAS worker, VAW worker and Service recipient will each receive a copy of the agreement. Both Peel CAS workers and VAW workers can access this agreement from their agencies.
